**Application** procedure:

The applicant completes the application form and written proposal and submits them to president@threeriverstesol.org. The board will review the application and notify successful applicants with a check by the end of May of each year.

Selection criteria:

Applications will be evaluated on the basis of (a) rationale, (b) relevance for ELL students, (c) objectives, (d) implementation plan, (e) how you will evaluate the success of the project, (f) plan for sharing/dissemination, and (g) budget. The applicant agrees to submit a newsletter article to Three Rivers TESOL describing his/her PD project if selected.

**Restrictions:** 

Grant cannot be used for (a) travel; (b) attending conferences; (c) course tuition or research projects associated with a degree program in which the applicant is enrolled; (d) testing fees.
